

- look at the <u>colours</u> used in the document. Are they ... ?
- $\Box$  cold colours (blue, white, green, grey...) : soft, sweet colours
- □ hot colours (red, yellow, pink...) : aggressive, shiny, bright colours
- □ both, it depends (try to justify the choices of the artist)

- look at the **<u>characters' faces</u>**. Are they...?

 $\hfill\square$  smiling, quiet, enthusiastic, pleased, satisfied...

□ sad, nervous, frightened, worried, sorry, tired, pale...

NOW, you can find **<u>adjectives</u>** corresponding to the atmosphere of the document :

unpleasant	tense	quiet	relaxed	comfortable
uncomfortable	frightening	sad	happy	scary
serious	friendly	dramatic	worrying
